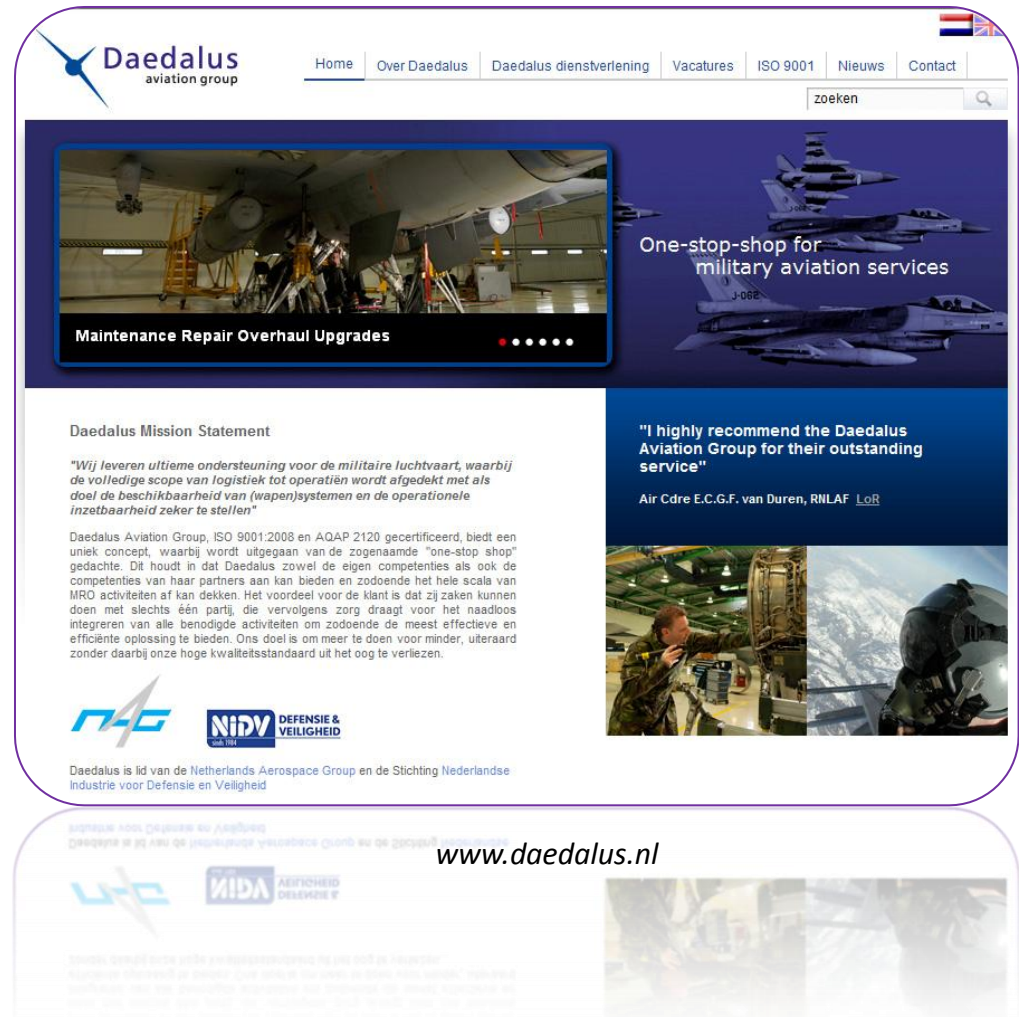


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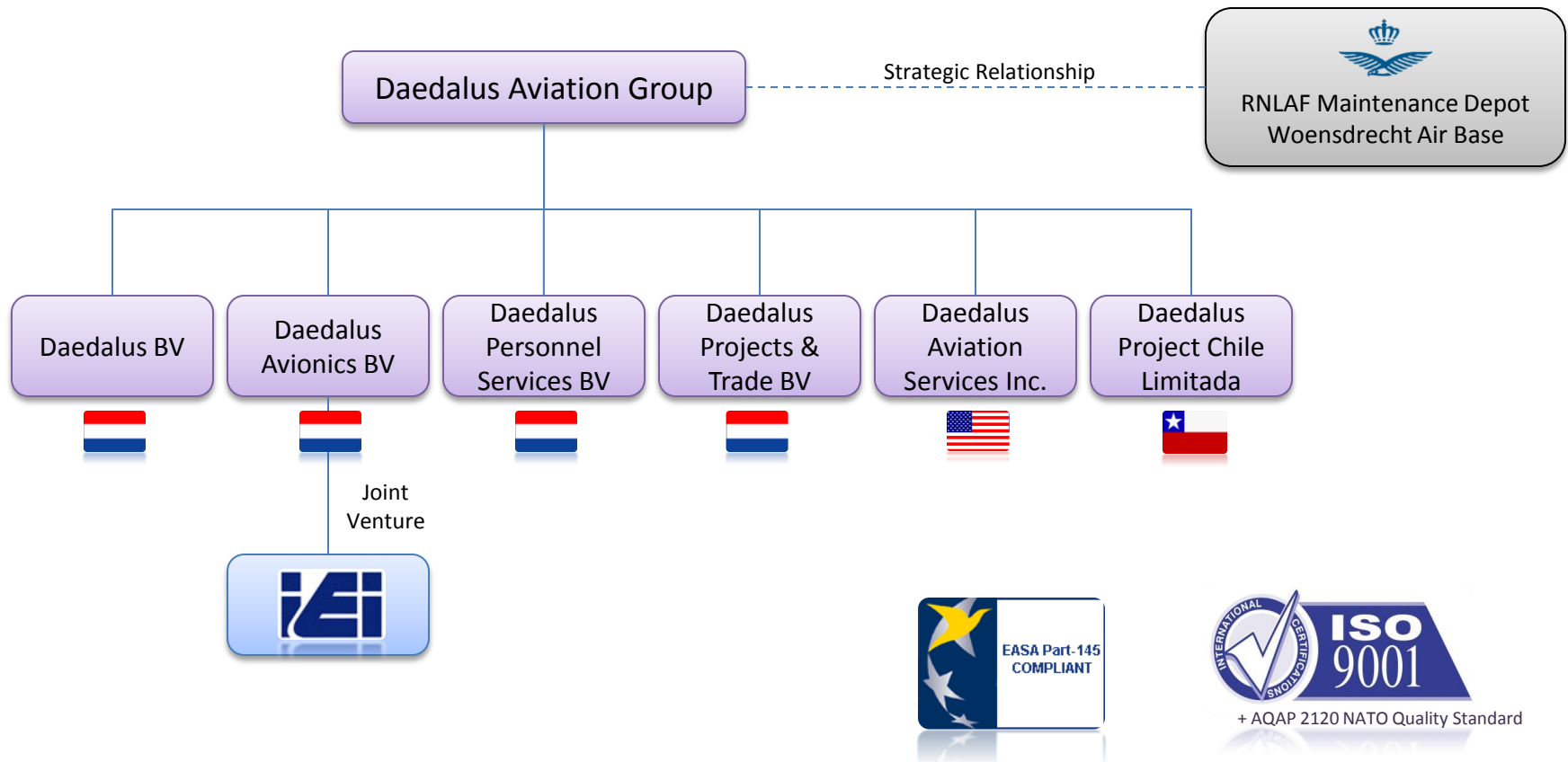
Mission Statement

 - EAS provided F-16 technical staff for RNLAf
 - RNLAf discontinued EAS contract, Daedalus BV took over the service
- Established as Daedalus Aviation Services in November 1994
 - Inc. established in Ogden, Utah to allow for effective hiring of US citizens
 - Providing and administrating technical staff for F-16 maintenance, repair and overhaul
- Current Headquarters: Tilburg, The Netherlands
 - Supporting worldwide operations
