"Deliver ultimate support for (military) aviation, covering the full scope from logistics to operations, in order to ensure optimal (weapon) system availability and operational readiness"




History

- The name "Daedalus" is derived from Greek Mythology
 - Father of Icarus
 - In etymological dictionary referred to as "super technician"
- Setup in October 1993 as Daedalus BV
 - Administration office for Elsinore Aerospace Services Inc. (EAS)
 - EAS provided F-16 technical staff for RNLAF
 - RNLAF discontinued EAS contract, Daedalus BV took over the service
- Established as Daedalus Aviation Services in November 1994
 - Inc. established in Ogden, Utah to allow for effective hiring of US citizens
 - Providing and administrating technical staff for F-16 maintenance, repair and overhaul
- Current Headquarters: Tilburg, The Netherlands
 - Supporting worldwide operations


